SPJ London's three-year, full-time undergraduate BSc Data Science (BDS) programme aims to produce graduates with an in-depth understanding of data science and solution-oriented techniques for analysing quantitative and qualitative data. Learning takes place at the SPJ London campus, with an optional semester in Year 2 dedicated to studying in the dynamic business hub of Sydney*.

Data plays a crucial role in driving decisions, innovation, productivity, and success. Blending ethics, employability skills, and industry-collaborated projects, this programme provides the practical experience necessary to address data expertise gaps in sectors such as IT, marketing, manufacturing, banking and finance, retail, and healthcare.

The range of learning and assessment methods in SPJ London programmes are designed to prepare you for this, aiming for maximum employment potential as soon as you graduate.

The Experiential Learning Model

We believe that learning should mirror real-world business dynamics. Our students flourish at the intersection of theory and practice. This is why our undergraduate programmes emphasise interactive elements such as business simulations, live projects, real-time trading, seminars, and robust partnerships between industry and academia.

Assessment

SPJ London's applied-learning approach to assessment ensures you graduate with practical, immediately applicable skills. Continuous assessment through individual and group assignments, class participation, simulations, projects, and mid-term and end-term examinations accurately quantifies your understanding and growth.

Expect diverse classrooms with students from a range of backgrounds and religions, from Chinese to Indian to Peruvian. There are many different cultures and ways of living among your peers, and you get to experience and understand them firsthand. Everyone has a very interesting story to tell.

Global learning

Your learning experience extends beyond the four walls of the classroom. In each city, students participate in structured global immersion activities that expose them to regional business practices, political systems, and cultures.

For example, during the exchange to Dubai, previous students visited the Burj Khalifa to understand the planning and vision behind its construction. In Singapore, previous students took back-office tours of the world's most expensive standalone casino, Marina Bay Sands, to observe and study its revenue model. In London, previous students have visited Salesforce's first Al Centre to learn about Al fundamentals and earn their Salesforce Al Associate Certificates.

This standout feature of the multicampus learning model allows students to truly immerse themselves in diverse cultures, emerging as knowledgeable and culturally enriched graduates.







Hands-on project experience

Regional Immersion Projects (RIPs)

Self-directed RIPs help you develop and maintain a professional portfolio through teamwork and collaboration with a designated mentor. During the project, you will identify suitable frameworks, models, and research approaches to address challenges within the contemporary global/regional business environment.

Capstone Project

Your learning culminates with a Capstone Project (either an Action Learning or Entrepreneurship Project), where acquired knowledge and skills are applied in a real-world setting.

The Action Learning Project option involves applying your knowledge and skills to deliver a written report and presentation on a real-world company problem. An Entrepreneurship Project applies the same skill sets to solving a consumer problem or need, with a view to launching your own business.

Tomorrow's learning technology, today

A leader in the education technology space, SPJ London's award winning digital teaching tools provide a unique, innovative learning experience, ideally equipping students for today's datadriven, disruptive business world.

Our technology-driven **Engaged Learning Classroom (ELC)** builds
practical, relevant skills in problemsolving, communication, critical thinking,
creativity and business intelligence.

An Engaged Learning Assistant (ELA) app also offers an individual learning experience; fostering a deeper understanding of course concepts, assisting with coursework and personalising learning pathways.

Explore Internship Opportunities

Although voluntary, students are highly encouraged to gain real-time exposure to global businesses through summer break internships. In the past, SP Jain Global undergraduates have interned with some of the world's top companies in Dubai, Singapore, and Sydney, including American Express, Apple, Ernst & Young, Forbes, Johnson & Johnson, KPMG and Unilever, building critical professional connections prior to graduation.

Blockchain-enabled degrees

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Step 1 Eligibility

All applicants are expected to

be predicted or have achieved 120 UCAS Tariff Points, equivalent to:

- → A-levels: BBB or equivalent
- → BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma: DDM
- → UCAS Tariff Points: 120
- → International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB): 30
- → BDS only: Mathematics is required.

In addition to the above: Minimum 5 GCSEs, including Grade C / 4 or higher for English and Maths.

For contextual admissions, international qualifications and English-language requirements, please refer to the SPJ London website **spjain.ac.uk**

Step 2 **Application**

Submit your application via UCAS.

UCAS Institutional Code: J01

Qualification results are not necessary at the time of application.





Step 3 **Evaluation**

Applicant shortlists are based on the following criteria:

- → Academic performance and other achievements
- → Your personal statement which describes how the programme meets your career aspirations
- → If applicable, English language proficiency score.

Step 4 Outcome

The Admissions Office aims to notify you of the outcome of your application within 14 working days.

As an applicant, you will then be invited to attend an optional on campus Applicant Day, and to join our online Unibuddy Community.





Personal **Interviews**

For contextual admissions, international applicants and those who narrowly miss our entry requirements, applicants will be required to undertake an online interview.







FEES, SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

Invest in a lifetime of growth

Your undergraduate degree is a steppingstone to a rewarding career and financial stability, and SPJ London is committed to empowering and supporting outstanding students to achieve their full potential.

Academic Merit Scholarship

To encourage high-calibre applicants, we offer individual scholarships to qualified candidates based on academic merit. Eligible applicants must apply and attend an interview assessment.

- → They are granted through a candidate-specific review process.
- → They can be taken as a tuition fee discount or as maintenance support through cash instalments.
- They are subject to meeting the grades outlined in your offer letter where required.
- → They are conditional upon recipients maintaining a required level of performance and attendance each academic year and abide by SPJ London's Code of Conduct.

Scholarship decisions are taken at the sole discretion of SPJ London.

Financial aid and assistance

A hardship fund is available by application to support any enrolled students experiencing financial difficulty during their studies.

Student Finance

Home students starting their first undergraduate degree may be eligible to apply for a full tuition fee loan and a maintenance loan.


The SPJ London Campus


